The Waldemar Pumphouse Water Storage Upgrade project is being completed to expand the water system to accommodate projected growth within Waldemar, and to increase the additional water storage available for fire protection. The Township has received the necessary funds from the developer to proceed with the project.

We wish to inform you that the construction is scheduled to commence in October 2023. The exact date of construction starting shall be posted on the Township website: <https://www.amaranth.ca/en/index.aspx> when available.



Public access to Waldemar Park through the gravel road shared with the Waldemar Pumphouse at 10 Station Street may be closed for periods of time during construction as required to ensure the public is protected from construction activities and equipment. When public access is closed, signage at the entrance of the driveway will be in place to advise that the entrance is closed. The public shall access the park by use of the walkway located off of St. John Street. People who may have accessibility concerns with the use of the walkway can contact Ed Jones (Xterra) directly and we can discuss arrangements to ensure you can access the park safely.

We anticipate that full and rolling road closures will be needed throughout the construction period for the delivery of equipment, materials, or for other construction activities. When these closures are required, notices will be provided to properties within the closure area and on the Township's website.

For properties within close proximity to the pumphouse building, residents will receive a request from the Contractor to complete a pre-construction survey in which they have a third-party document conditions inside and outside of the house. As the owner you can receive a copy of this report as well. There is also a third-party who will be conducting vibration monitoring during construction, and they may ask permission to install sensors as part of their monitoring program.

Safety is our prime concern, and we ask that you consider the following:

- Take extra care when travelling near the construction site. Expect that some delays may occur due to a minor increase in traffic volume. The Contractor will have personnel on-site to facilitate access along Station Street as required.
- The Contractor is aware of the Township's noise by-law requirements restricting construction time from 6:00 am to 11:00 pm. The Contractor's typical working hours are between 6:00 am to 6:00 pm, but may vary from time to time depending on weather and the manner of work being completed.
- At the end of the workday, the Contractor will ensure those residents who access Station Street in the construction area have access to their properties.
