WINTER PARKING

TAKE NOTICE THAT UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ACT, SECTION 170, SUBSECTION 12 AND SECTION 181

No person shall park or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or unattended, upon any road in such a manner as to interfere with snow removal operations. Any vehicle obstructing snow removal operations will be referred to the OPP and shall be removed at the owner's expense. For proper driveway snow removal, please ensure when clearing your driveway that snow is not deposited onto the roadway. No person shall deposit snow onto the road or road allowance. Please note that this includes pushing the snow across the road onto the road allowance.

FIRE SAFETY INFORMATION

Fire permits are required, at no charge, for all burning within the Township. Fires are to be in accordance with Fire By-law 05-2009. Permit applications are available online at:

TAX INFORMATION

We are now offering a Pre-Authorized Payment Plan in 2 forms; Due Date and Monthly plans (Please see insert enclosed with the tax bill for more information). Penalty and Interest is added to the tax account on a monthly basis on past due accounts. Arrears notices will be mailed 4 times per year, the month after the tax installment due date.

Tax payments can also be made through your online banking or cash/cheque at the Township Office.

PLANNING INQUIRIES

If you wish to speak with a staff member regarding a planning, zoning or development inquiry please email your request to planner@amaranth.ca or 519-941-1007 x228. Any importation/exportation of fill requires a Township approval and/or Conservation Authority permit prior to any site alteration. Township fill applications must be requested in writing for approval by Council in accordance with Site Alteration By-Law 65-2009 (available on Township website). Violations will be investigated and appropriate action taken.

BUILDING PERMITS

All building permits are facilitated through the County of Dufferin's new e-permitting platform. You can submit an application, check permit status, schedule inspections and find more information at:

BY-LAW ENFORCEMENT

The Township's Zoning By-Law 2-2009 outlines the permitted uses of all properties throughout the Township. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of the By-Law is guilty of an offense and upon conviction shall pay a fine. Any building or structure which contravenes any requirement of the By-Law may be removed or altered at the instance of the Township pursuant to the provisions of the *Municipal Act*. If you notice a violation of the Zoning By-Law please report it to the Township Office. The By-Law Enforcement Officer will investigate and follow up. DOG TAGS

Residents are required to obtain a yearly dog tag for each dog they own or that resides on the property, pursuant to By-law 45-2005 and to notify the Township if a dog is not registered. Dogs running at large are prohibited in the Township. Unpaid dog tag invoices will be added to property tax accounts.
