Mysterious worlds of the subconscious surface in her works, introducing you to imagery familiar and yet totally unique and compelling.

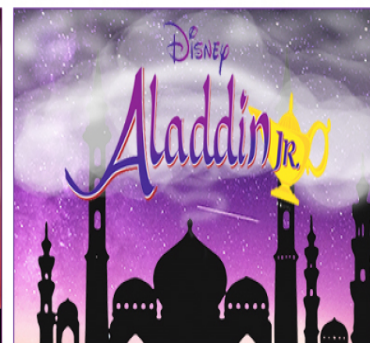
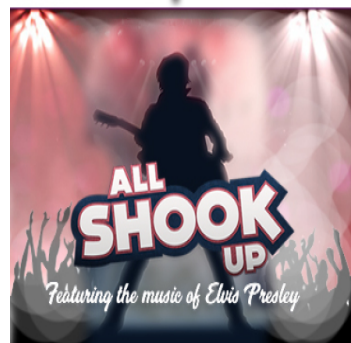

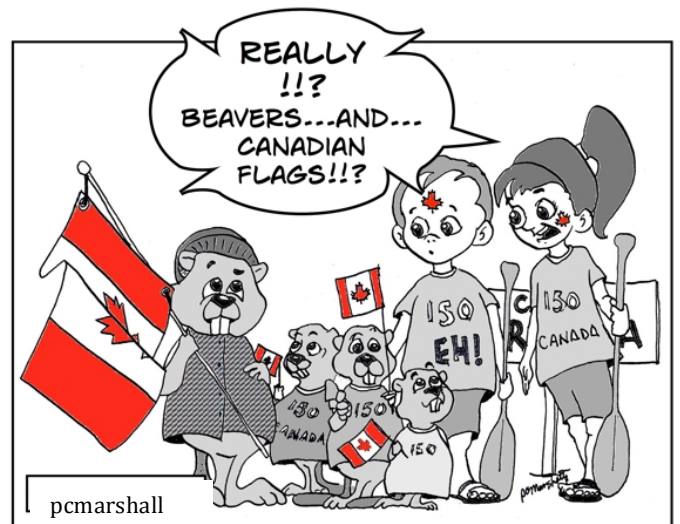
