Township of Amaranth opens Bridge #17

The Township of Amaranth is excited to announce the Official Opening of the newly-refurbished Bridge 17.

The bridge was transformed from a single lane model to a modern two-lane structure. In addition, the road profile was realigned to raise the height of the bridge deck and improve sight lines. Modifications also included enhancing the weight bearing capacity of the bridge to help accommodate the increased amount of traffic and heavy equipment.

Although the former bridge was well used by the local residents and businesses, the agricultural community and residents are very pleased with the new two-lane bridge and the support received from the Province for the necessary replacement.
