Since the first meeting in October 2020, the ADEICAC has begun the process of embedding equity, diversion and inclusion into the Township practices in different ways. The Committee has met 4 times since its inception, in October and December of 2020 and February and May of 2021, to

create Terms of Reference, goals and an action plan for the 2020/2021 year. The pandemic made it difficult to see some goals to fruition, but the ADEICAC has accomplished much in terms of setting up for the future of Equity and Diversity in Amaranth Township. With the support of both the community and Township Council, the ADEICAC has begun to make changes that reflect diverse identities within the Township, given opportunities for diverse voices to be heard, and encouraged representation and celebration of all members of the Amaranth Community.
